Airmen assigned overseas must have or obtain at least 12 months retainability within 30 days of receipt of their DEROS Option and Forecast Notification RIP. If no action is taken by the suspense, an AF Form 964, "PCS, TDY, or Training Declination Statement" will be completed on the member's behalf and updated in the member's record. This statement signifies the member's acknowledgement of declination to obtain the retainability and the member will no longer be eligible for PCS assignment. Specific rules apply for First Term and Second Term Airmen.
