ON

DOS ROLLBACK ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA: PHASE II

Eligible

- Airmen must have less than 14 years TAFMS as of June 30, 2010 or 20 years or more TAFMS on or before June 30, 2010, and
- have a DOS of June 30, 2010 or later, and
- possess at least one of the codes listed below which expires on or after June 30, 2010 or must have been denied reenlistment by their commander under the FY10 DOS Rollback

RE/AAC Code and Reason

- 2X: Denied reenlistment
- 3D: Declined PCS Retainability (commanders may not change)
- 3E: Declined training (commanders may not change)
- 4E: Grade is A1C or below and Airman who completed 31 or more months (55 months for 6-year enlistees), if a first-term Airman; or, grade is A1C or below and the Airman is a second-term or career Airman (Commanders may not change; member must meet promotion eligibility conditions and be selected for promotion to SrA prior to June 30, 2010)
- 4H: Serving suspended punishment pursuant to an Article 15
- 4I: Serving on the Control Roster
- AAC08: Declines retainability for a controlled duty assignment or training (commanders may not change)
- AAC09: Airman declined to extend or reenlist for retainability for a PCS or TDY (commanders may not change)
- AAC10: Denied reenlistment
- AAC12: Article 15 punishment
- AAC16: Control Roster
 - RE codes 2X, 3D, and 3E, and AAC 08, 09 AND 10 do not expire
