LIMITED ACTIVE DUTY SERVICE COMMITMENT WAIVERS ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR OFFICER AND ENLISTED

Eligible

- Effective 25 Mar - 30 June 10, officers and enlisted in the Primary Air Force Specialties (PAFS) listed below may apply for a retirement/separation date to be effective no later than September 1, 2010
 - AFSs may be removed from eligibility with little or no notice
 - Air Force will remove AFSs from consideration when desired force sustainment levels within an AFSC are met

Officer

- Officers possessing a Primary AFS (PAFS) listed below are eligible to apply under the LADSC Waiver Program
 - Colonel and Colonel(S) Primary AFS: 13B, 13S, 15W, 21A, 21M, 33S, 38F, 52R, 71S
 - Lieutenant Colonels and below Core ID/Flag: 13S, 15W, 21A, 21M, 21R, 33S, 38F, 52R (except Catholic Chaplains), 61A, 61B, 61C, 61D, 62E*, 63A, 65F, and 71S. (Note: Lt Cols and below in AFS 62E are not eligible for tuition assistance waivers.)
- Time in Grade Waivers
 - Colonels and Colonel(S) in line AFSs and Lieutenant Colonels and below regardless of AFS (except medical officers) may apply for time in grade (TIG) waivers for the purpose of retirement
 - May also apply for a LADSC waiver in conjunction with a TIG waiver
 - Request for time in grade waivers will be handled on a case by case basis.

Enlisted

- Enlisted personnel possessing a Primary AFSC (PAFSC) or CEM codes as listed below are eligible to apply under the LADSC Waiver Program
 - Chiefs and Chief(S) CEM Codes: 1A1, 1C3, 1P, 1W, 2A6, 2R0, 2T0, 2T1, 2W0, 2W1, 3D, 3D1, 3N0, 3S0, 4Y0, 5J, 6F, 8F, and 8R3
 - Senior Master Sergeant and below Primary AFSC: 2A0X1P, 2A0X1S, 2A3X2, 2A6X1, 2A6X2, 2S0X1, 2T0X1, 2W1X1, 3D0X4, 3D1X1, 3D1X2, 3D1X3, 3M0X1, 3S2X1, 4A0X1, and 4Y0X1
