**Privacy Act Statement**

**AUTHORITY:** Title 10 U. S. C. 8012 and U.S.C. 31012.

**PRINCIPLE PURPOSES:** To register dependent youth of military, retired and DoD personnel to use the Andersen Air Force Base Pool. Providing the Andersen Air Force Base Pool Program the authorization for medical treatment in emergency situations; record youth/family information; photo use authorization; and releasing of liability.

**ROUTINE USES:** This information may be disclosed to any DoD component or part thereof, and upon request to other Federal, State and local government agencies in the pursuit of their official duties; disclosed to news media; used for other lawful purposes including law enforcement and litigation.

**DISCLOSURE IS VOLUNTARY:** Failure to provide the information may preclude the individual from participation in the Andersen Air Force Base Pool Program and Air Force sponsored pool programs.

**Privacy Act Statement**

**GENERAL POOL RULES:**

- Only authorized patrons and their accompanied guests are permitted to utilize pool facilities.
- Children 10 or younger must be under the direct supervision of an adult. An adult is considered anyone who is at least 18 years old. Supervision requires the adult supervisor to be in the water with the child at all times, observing and correcting the child's behavior as well as being able to provide immediate assistance to the child if necessary.
- Children 11 through 15 must pass a swim test or be supervised by an adult.
- Only children enrolled in the Andersen Air Force Base Pool program will be allowed entry into the pool and surrounding area. Enrollment must be signed by parent or legal guardian only
- Lifeguards will enforce all rules to ensure a safe swimming environment.
- No breath holding contests or training permitted.
- All patrons and accompanied guests must sign in/out at the front desk when entering/exiting the pool complex.
- Food and beverages prohibited on or around pool deck areas.
- Glass containers are prohibited.
- Smoking is prohibited in or around the pool complex.
- Individuals with obvious evidence of a cold or other communicable disease, open sores or lesions, including fungal skin diseases, are prohibited from entering pool.
- Children not toilet trained must wear snug-fitting plastic pants.
- Only properly fitted U.S. Coast Guard (USCG) approved flotation devices (lifejackets) type I, II, or III are allowed during open recreational swimming.
- Showers are required before entering pool.
- Lifeguards may clear pool areas during electrical storms and at other times deemed necessary in the interest of safety.
  
- No diving at shallow end of pool.
- No running, horseplay, or pushing of people in or around pool.

**BABY POOL RULES:**

- Maximum Depth is 2 feet. No jumping, diving, or belly flops into pool.
- Children cannot be left unattended in baby pool area at any time.

**DIVING BOARD RULES:**

- Only one person at a time.
- No running on board.
- Only one bounce.
- Clear landing area after entering pool.
- No diving with lifejacket, goggles, or masks.
- No jumping from side of board. Jump straight out.
- Do not adjust the fulcrum.
- No swimming under or around diving board while in use.

**SLIDE RULES:**

- Only one person at a time.
- Riders must go feet first, lying on their backs.
- Clear landing area after entering pool.
