

TARAGUE BEACH RESERVATION POLICY (May 2011)

By initializing the statements below I agree to abide by all policies set forth.

BEACH RULES:

- 1) _____ In case of emergencies, there is a telephone located on the telephone pole across from Bamboo Willies on the beach side. Dial 911 and let them know your calling from AAFB so they can transfer you to the Andersen Fire Dept. Request you check to ensure the Tarague emergency phone (on yellow pole close to the concrete beach building) is working before you enter the water.
- 2) _____ Absolutely no motor vehicles are allowed on the beach
- 3) _____ Tarague Beach is a SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK beach
- 4) _____ Swimming is only permitted within the designated buoyed area during the designated hours (0630-1830)
- 5) _____ Reef walking is strictly prohibited. Be aware of strong currents and riptides.
- 6) _____ Buddy System will be strictly enforced
 - a) The buddy "Wing Man" system requests that before anyone enters the water entry, a minimum of two (2) or more responsible individuals must be on the beach or in the water at all times.
- 7) _____ Pay attention to the color coded warning signs
- 8) _____ NEVER enter the water or swim alone - safety is our primary concern.
- 9) _____ NEVER swim after drinking.
- 10) _____ We ask your assistance in enforcing safety -- you may save a life.
- 11) _____ Please immediately report any infractions to Security Forces or Outdoor Recreation Department at 366-5197
- 12) Scuba diving is prohibited.
- 13) _____ Removing coral, shells, plants and foliage is prohibited.
- 14) _____ Pole fishing is permitted 50 feet outside the swimming area. A fishing permit must be obtained from Outdoor Recreation.
- 15) _____ No glass containers.
- 16) _____ No pets are allowed in the Tarague Basin at any time.
- 17) _____ Absolutely NO Motor Vehicles such as 4-wheelers are allowed anywhere within the Tarague Basin Preserve.
- 18) _____ Food and beverages are prohibited in the water.
- 19) _____ All trash must be placed in the trash containers or the dumpster. If trash is over flowing, please throw the trash in the dumpster.
- 20) _____ Vehicles are prohibited on the beach side.
- 21) **CAMPFIRES:** _____
 - a) Campfires must be contained such as in a barbeque grill or drum.
 - b) The collection of rocks with the intention of creating fire rings is prohibited.
 - c) Ground Bon Fires of any type are strictly prohibited anywhere within the Tarague Basin.
- 22) _____ Cancellations must be made within 48 hours of your reservation.

There are 3 different sites for Tarague Beach:

23) CAMPING SITES:

- a) Campsites are numbered 1-13 and 28-33.
- b) Reservation starts at 1200 to 1100 the following day.
- c) Fee will be \$10 per campsite.

24) DAY USE SITES:

- a) No fee day use sites are numbered 14-27. Absolutely no over night camping in these areas.
- b) Reservation is from 0800-1800

25) SQUADRON FUNCTION AREAS:

- a) Located on the cliff side of the beach on both sides of Bamboo Willies. These are designated for Squadron functions of more than 50 people.
