

**NetLibrary:** NetLibrary offers libraries and organizations around the world the most comprehensive collection of electronic books (eBooks) available, making it possible for you to access a wide range of research, reference, and reading materials online. **Gale:** Includes "Biographical Resource Material including MARQUIS Who's Who." This database is excellent for finding biographical information of people around the world. You can search for people based on one or more personal facts such as birth and death year, nationality, ethnicity, occupation or gender, or combine criteria to create highly targeted information on social issues. The researcher may access viewpoint articles, topic overviews, statistics, primary documents, links to websites, and full-text magazine and newspaper articles.
